Marcos Kisil is the President of IDIS. Prior to this appointment, he was the W. K. Kellogg Foundation's Regional Director for Latin America and the Caribbean, where he directed the programmatic and strategic development of the Foundation's action in Latin America. Marcos Kisil is a medical doctor graduated from the University of São Paulo's School of Medicine. Subsequently, he dedicated himself to the field of health management, and went on to earn his doctoral degree in Administration from George Washington University in Washington, DC, on a grant from the W.K. Kellogg Foundation. Dr. Kisil acted as consultant for the Pan American Health Organization. He engages in academic activities as a tenured professor of the University of São Paulo's School of Public Health. Today, he serves on the Administrative Boards of various organizations, including FGV's Escola de Administração de Empresas de São Paulo (São Paulo School of Business Administration) and Associação Brasileira de Desenvolvimento de Lideranças (Brazilian Association for the Development of Leaderships). Dr. Kisil was also President of the Board of GIFE, Director President of the WCF-Brazil Institute, and a member of the Administrative Board of the Fundação Banco do Brasil (Bank of Brazil Foundation) and of the WWF-Brazil.
